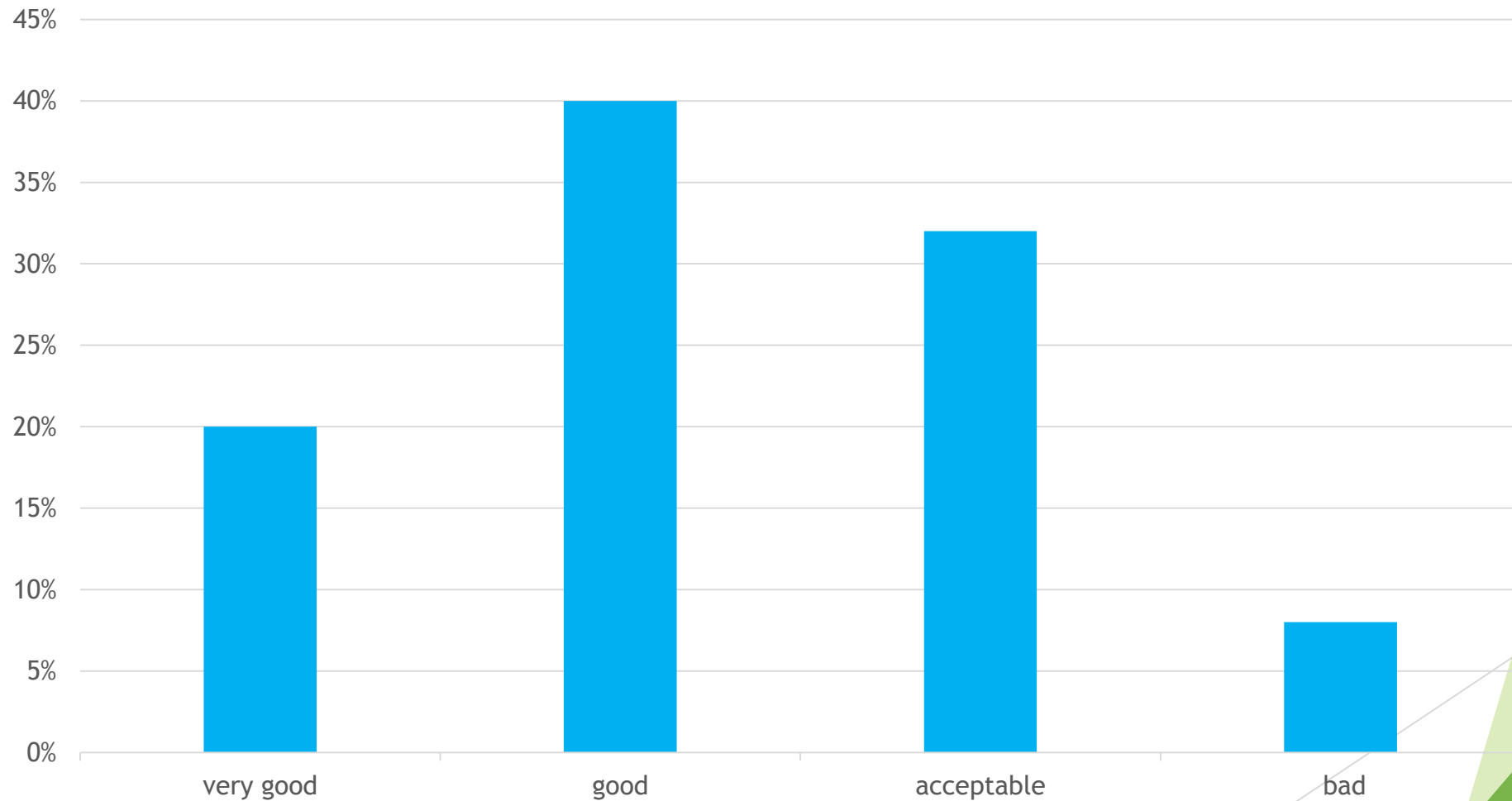

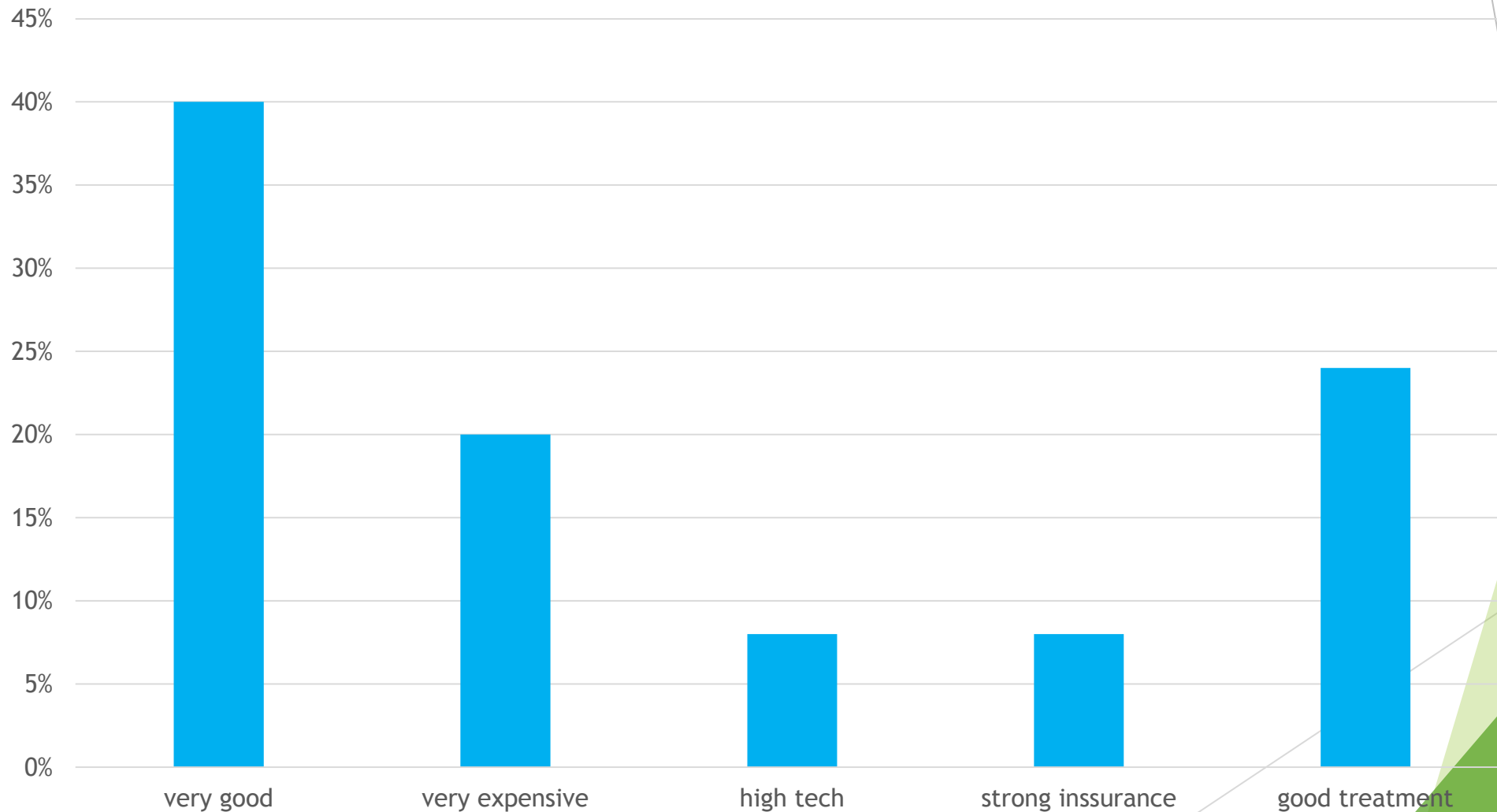
# What was the health system in your home country like?



# Reasons

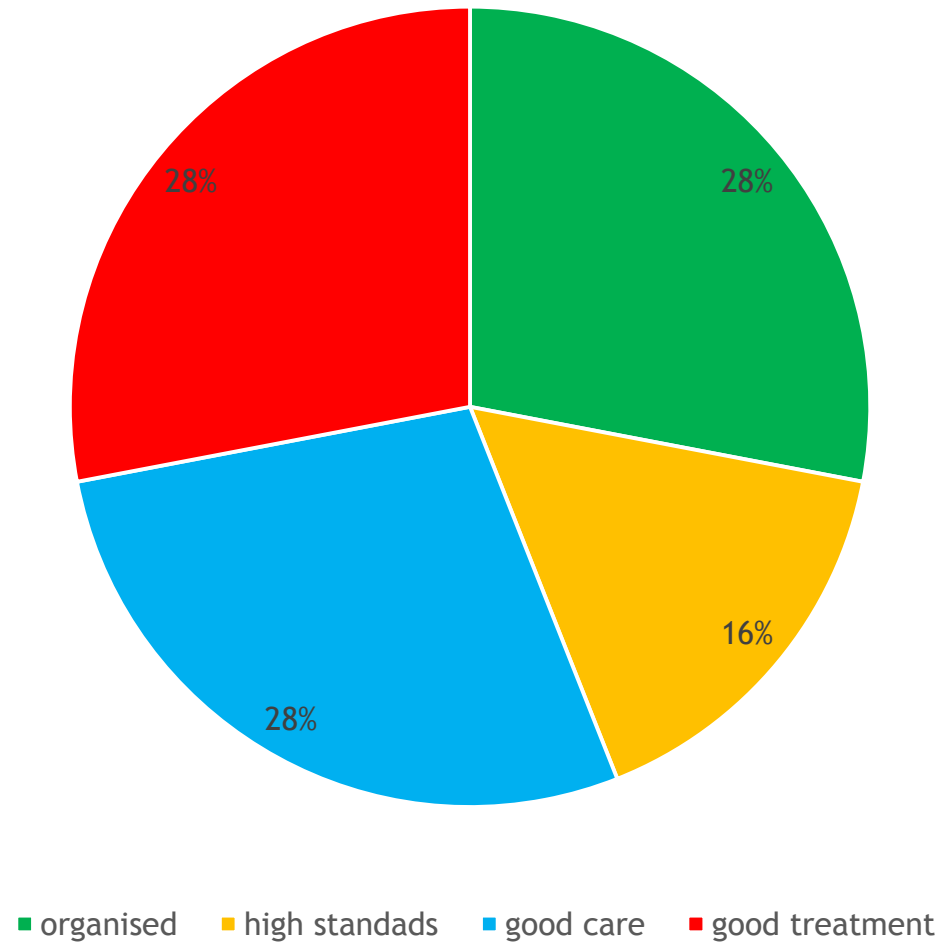
- Very Good: because of fast appointments and fast treatment.

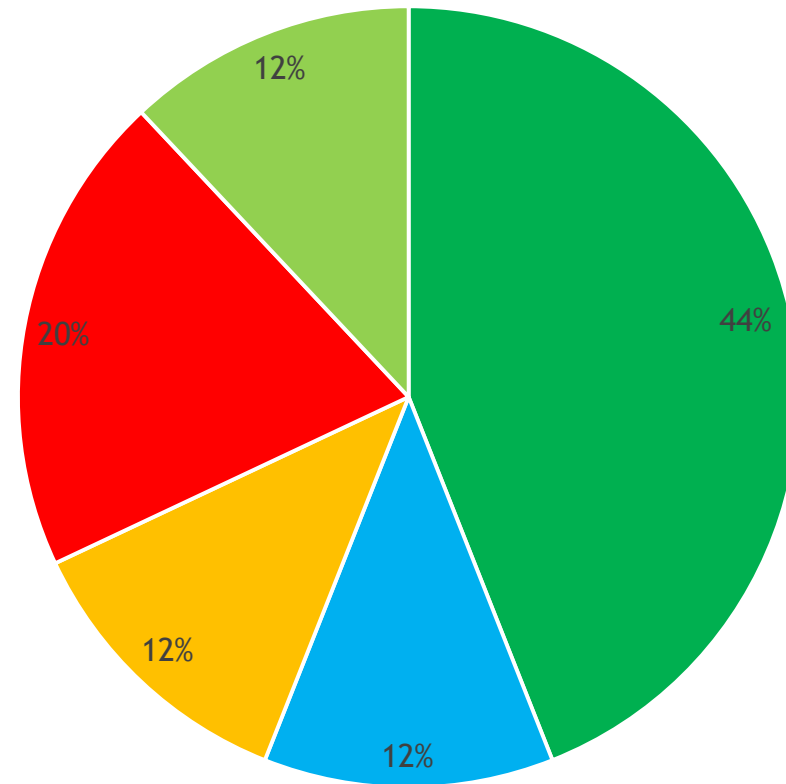

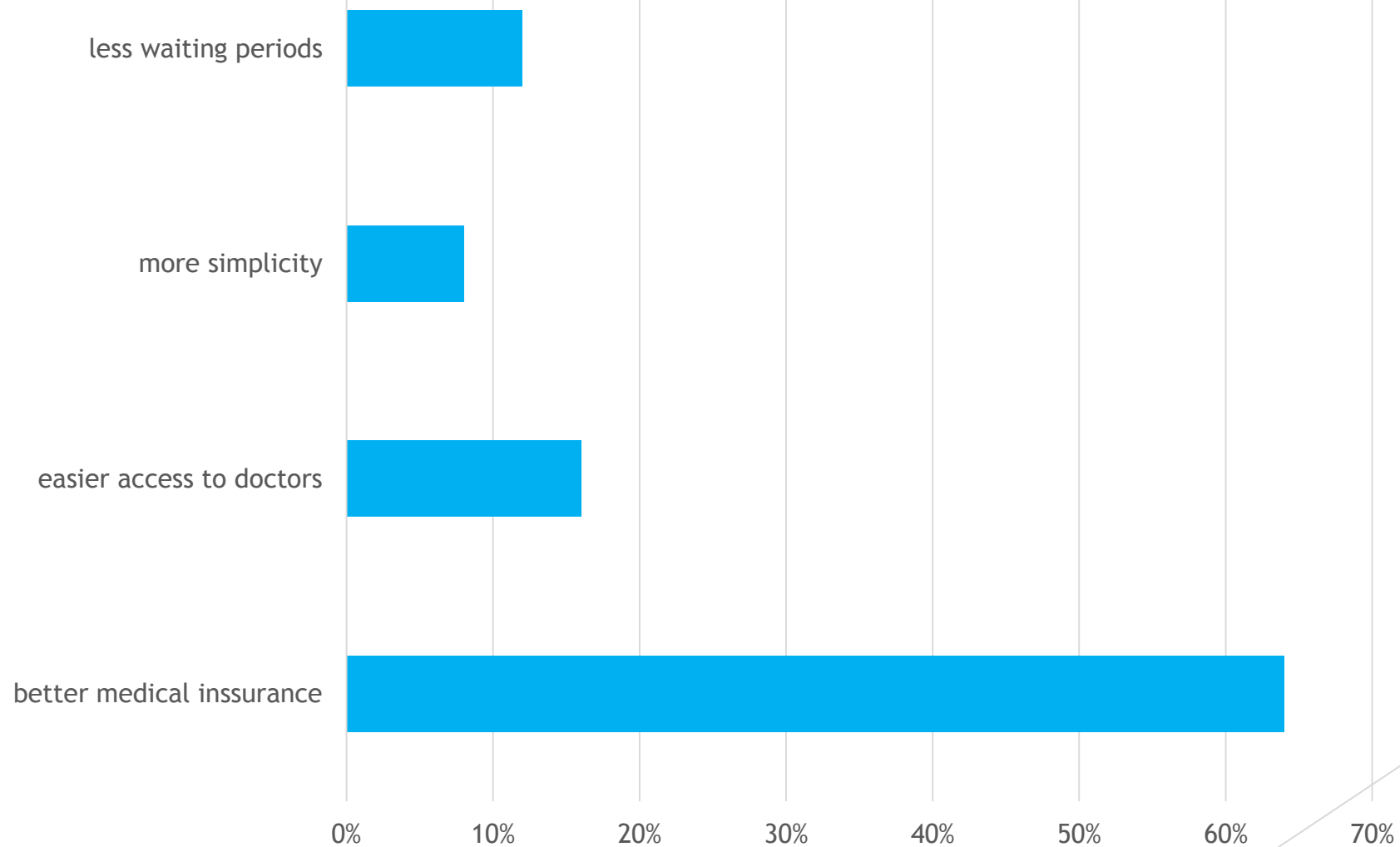
