

Referral Guidelines to Metro South Clinical Tuberculosis Service

Please use this form for all new refugee arrivals to Australia for routine screening.

- Generate form after live vaccines have been administered
- The **top part of the form is for the MSCTBS label – do not fill this in please**
- For organisations which generate their own labels please **insert your patient label in the patient detail section.**
- The country of origin/language/interpreter needs to be completed for appointments and for quality purposes.
- Providing the name of the Family Contact will assist with keeping families together for appointments- so please complete this section too
- **Preliminary bloods** are not required as part of the referral process however if they have been taken please complete this section
- **Results will be faxed back to the GP so please ensure the “From” section includes the fax number of the GP**

For all individuals with clinical indicators for suspected TB- the GP is required to send a GP letter directly to the Medical Practitioner at MSCTBS please.
