If you have a dental emergency but no time has been arranged for an interpreter to be available, your dentist may have a look at your problem and provide a temporary solution. This could be some medication (for pain or antibiotics for infection). Please do not worry if your dentist cannot fix your problem straight away. It is for your safety that complex treatment is completed when you fully understand the risks of what will be involved and when an interpreter is available. This will all be arranged for you.
