

Entering and leaving Australia

Travelling from Australia

- [Request your International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate](#)
- Check the current travel, travel insurance, visa and COVID-19 advice for all the countries you are transiting through and travelling to using [Smartraveller](#).
- Check with your airline to see if they have specific requirements that you need to meet. You may need to show proof a negative test before you can board / at check-in, if the airline requests this.



While travelling

Travelling back to Australia

- You do not need to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test to travel to Australia. Some countries, airlines and vessel operators may require a pre-departure test result at check-in before you can board your flight or ship. Check the entry requirements of your airline or vessel operator's requirements. Visit the [Smartraveller](#) website for more information.
- See [Australian Border Force](#) to find out what you can bring in and out of Australia, and what items need to be declared. There are fines if this advice is not followed.
