

Free COVID-19 RAT Kits

For Pacific Australia Labour Mobility workers - August 2022

This factsheet explains how workers under the [Pacific Australia Labour Mobility scheme](#) can now access free COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) kits.

Queensland Health is providing free RAT kits to people who have Australian Government concession cards. Most people working through the Pacific Labour Scheme (PLS) and Seasonal Worker Program (SWP) will not be eligible for these. For this reason, Queensland Health has expanded its eligibility for accessing RAT kits.

If you are a worker under the Pacific Australia Labour Mobility scheme, you can now access RAT kits for free. You can collect up to 5 RAT tests per month and collect all 5 RAT kits in a single visit.

Where can I get a free RAT kit?

Queensland Health is now distributing RAT kits at many locations in the community. Find your nearest distribution point [here](#), or scan the QR code below.

What do I need to show the staff at the distribution point?

1. Tell staff that you are a worker under the Pacific Australia Labour Mobility Scheme.
2. Show staff your passport and evidence of your Temporary Work (International Relations) visa (subclass 403).
3. You can show this fact sheet to staff if they are unaware of your eligibility.

You will need to provide this information every time you visit a distribution point. Wear a face mask if you have any COVID-19 symptoms.

Where can I get help if I have COVID-19?

If you test positive for COVID-19 you should [report your RAT test result here](#). From **Friday 9 September 2022**, the COVID-19 isolation period has been reduced from 7 days to 5 days, provided you have no symptoms and don't work in aged care, disability care or home care. All other isolation requirements will remain the same. [Click here](#) for more information.

Mo le au gālulue I le Pacific Australia Labour Mobility- Aokuso 2022

O lenei pepa e fa'amatala mai ai le auala ua mafai ai e tagata o gālulue i lalo o le [Pacific Australia Labour Mobility scheme](#) ona maua fua pusa o le COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test (RAT).

Ua saunia e le Soifua Mālōlōina i Ausetalia ni pusa e aunoa ma se totogi mo tagata o lo'o iai ni pepa fa'amaonia ale Malo o Ausetalia. O le toatele o tagata o lo'o gālulue i le Pacific Labour Scheme (PLS) ma Tagata Faigāluega o le Vaitau (SWP) e lē agavaa mo nei ia pepa fa'amaonia. O le māfuaaga lea ua fa'ateleina ai e le Soifua Mālōlōina i Kuniselani lea agava'a mo le mauaina o RAT kits.

Afai o oe o se tagata faigāluega i lalo o le Pacific Australia Labour Mobility, ua mafai nei ona e maua Rat kits e aunoa ma se totogi. E mafai ona e aoina mai e o'o atu i le 5 RAT kits i le masina I se asiasiga e tasi.

O fea e mafai ona ou maua ai nei RAT kit e aunoa ma se totogi?

Ua tufatufaina atu nei e le Soifua Mālōlōina a Kuniselani pusa (RAT kits) I nofoaga 'eseese i nu'u. Saili le nu'u aupito lata ia oe l'inei ([here](#)), pe tagai i le numera fa'ailo QR o lo'o i lalo.

O le a se mea e mana'omia ona ou fa'aali atu i le aufāigaluega i le nofoaga o tufa ai RAT kits?

1. Ta'u atu i le aufāigaluega o oe o se tagata faigāluega i lalo o le Pacific Australia Labour Mobility Scheme.
2. Fa'aali atu i le aufāigaluega lou tusifolau ma fa'amaoniga o lau visa lē tumau o Gāluega (So'otaga Fa'avaomalo) (subclass 403).
3. E mafai ona e fa'aali atu lenei pepa i le aufaigāluega pe'a fai latou te lē o iloaina lou agavaa.

O le a mana'omia ona e tu'uina atu nei fa'amatalaga i taimi uma e te asiasi ai i se nofoaga o tufaina ai pusa o su'ega (Rat kits). Fai sau tali fofoga pe afai e i ai ni ou āuga o le COVID-19.

E fa'apefea ona ou fa'aaogaina le RAT kit?

E mafai ona e mauaina fa'amatalaga I le fa'aaogaina o RAT kits i isi gagana l'inei([here](#)), pe matamata i se vitiō o fa'atonuga I isi gagana iinei ([here](#)).

O fea e mafai ona ou maua ai se fesoasoani pe afai ua ou maua I le COVID-19?

Afai ua positive lau su'ega o le COVID-19 e tatau ona e lipoti iinei [report your RAT test result here](#). Mai le Aso Faraile 9 Setema 2022, ua fa'aitiitia aso o le nofoesea o le COVID-19 mai le 7 aso i le 5 aso, pe afai e lē o iai ni ou āuga ma e te lē faigāluega I nofoaga o tagata matutua, nofoaga o tagata e iai mana'oga fa'apitoa po'o le tausiga o le aiga.
