

Free COVID-19 RAT Kits

For Pacific Australia Labour Mobility workers - August 2022

This factsheet explains how workers under the [Pacific Australia Labour Mobility scheme](#) can now access free COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) kits.

Queensland Health is providing free RAT kits to people who have Australian Government concession cards. Most people working through the Pacific Labour Scheme (PLS) and Seasonal Worker Program (SWP) will not be eligible for these. For this reason, Queensland Health has expanded its eligibility for accessing RAT kits.

If you are a worker under the Pacific Australia Labour Mobility scheme, you can now access RAT kits for free. You can collect up to 5 RAT tests per month and collect all 5 RAT kits in a single visit.

Where can I get a free RAT kit?

Queensland Health is now distributing RAT kits at many locations in the community. Find your nearest distribution point [here](#), or scan the QR code below.

What do I need to show the staff at the distribution point?

1. Tell staff that you are a worker under the Pacific Australia Labour Mobility Scheme.
2. Show staff your passport and evidence of your Temporary Work (International Relations) visa (subclass 403).
3. You can show this fact sheet to staff if they are unaware of your eligibility.

You will need to provide this information every time you visit a distribution point. Wear a face mask if you have any COVID-19 symptoms.

Where can I get help if I have COVID-19?

If you test positive for COVID-19 you should [report your RAT test result here](#). From **Friday 9 September 2022**, the COVID-19 isolation period has been reduced from 7 days to 5 days, provided you have no symptoms and don't work in aged care, disability care or home care. Me'asivi KOVITI-19 RAT ta'etotongi

Ma'ae Kau Folaunga Leipa ki 'Aositelelia Mei he Pasifiki- 'Akosi 2022

Ko e tohi fakamatala ni 'oku ne fakamatala'i 'a e founa 'e lava ai 'a e kau ngaue ko ia folau mai 'i he [Pacific Australia Labour Mobility scheme \(Kau Folaunga-Leipa ki 'Aositelelia\)](#) ke nau ma'u 'o ngaue'aki 'i he taimi lolotonga ni 'a e ngaahi Me'asivi 'Enitiseni KOVITI-19 fakavavevave (RAT) ta'etotongi.

'Oku tuku atu ta'etotongi 'e he pule'anga 'o Kuinisolani 'a e ngaahi me'asivi RAT kiate kinautolu kotoa ko ia 'oku 'i ai ha'anau kaati konisesoni mei he Pule'anga 'Aositelelia. Ko e tokolahi taha 'o kinautolu ko ia 'oku nau ngaue 'i he Sikiimi Kau Folaunga Leipa (Pacific Labour Scheme (PLS)) mo e Kau Ngaue Toli Fua'itakau Fakafa'ahi ta'u mei he Pasifiki (SWP) 'e 'ikai ke nau 'ataa ki he ngaahi faingamalie ko 'eni. Pea ko e 'uhinga ia, 'oku fao atu ai 'e he Potungaue Mo'ui 'a Kuinisolani ke nau faka'ataa 'a e faingamalie ko 'eni ki he ngaahi me'asivi ni (RAT).

Kapau ko ha tokotaha ngaue ko e 'i he Sikiimi Kau Folaunga Leipa 'a 'Aositelelia, 'oku ke 'ataa he taimi ni ke ke ngaue'aki ta'etotongi 'a e ngaahi me'asivi RAT. Te ke lava 'o ngaue'aki ha me'asivi RAT 'e 5 'i he mahina pea 'oku lava pe ke piki faka'angataha mai pe kinautolu ia 'i he fo'i fononga pe 'e taha.

Teu ma'u mei fe 'a e me'asivi RAT ta'etotongi ?

'Oku lolotonga tufaki atu 'e he Potungaue Mo'ui 'a Kuinisolani 'a e ngaahi me'asivi RAT ki he ngaahi feitu'u lahi 'i he komiuniti. Hanga 'o kumi 'a e feitu'u ofi taha ko ia 'oku tufaki atu ai 'i heni [here](#), pe ko ho'o sikeeni 'a e kouti QR 'oku ha atu 'i lalo.

Ko e ha e me'a 'e fiema'u ke u fakahaa ki he kau ngaue 'i he feitu'u tufaki?

1. Tala ange ki he kau ngaue ko e tokotaha ngaue koe 'i he Sikiimi Fefolau'aki Ngaue Leipa 'a 'Aositelelia.
2. Fakaha ki he kau ngaue 'a ho'o paasipooti mo e fakamo'oni 'o ho'o Visa Ngaue Fakataimi (International Relations) visa (subcalss 403)
3. Te ke lava foki 'o fakahaa'i ange 'a e tohi ni kapau 'oku 'ikai te nau 'ilo 'oku 'i ai 'a ho'o totonu ki ai.

'E fiema'u ke ke 'oange ma'u pe 'a e ngaahi fakaikiiki kuo hiki atu 'i he taimi kotoa pe te ke 'alu ai ki he fai'anga tufaki ni. Tui ma'u pe 'a e me'a malu'i fofonga 'o kapau 'oku ke ongo'i ha faka'ilonga 'o e KOVITI-19.

'Oku anga fefe hono ngaue'aki 'a e me'asivi RAT?

'Oku ke lava 'o ma'u e ngaahi fakahinohino ki hono ngaue'aki'o e me'asivi RAT 'i heni [here](#), pe ko ha'o sio 'i he vitio 'o hono fai 'o e sivi 'i he ihu 'i he ngaahi lea fakafonua kehe 'i heni. [here](#).

Teu ma'u mei fe ha tokoni 'o kapau 'oku ou puke 'i he KOVIT-19?

Kapau 'oku ke ma'u ha ola positivi 'i ha'o sivi KOVITI-19 'oku tonu leva ke ke lipooti ki he [report your RAT test result here](#). Mei he **Falaite 'aho 9 'o Sepitema 2022**, ko e taimi 'aisoleiti KOVITI-19 kuo holoki hifo mei 'aho 'e 7 ki ha 'aho pe 'e 5, 'o kapau 'oku 'ikai te ke ongo'i ha fa'ahinga faka'ilonga pea 'oku 'ikai ke ke ngaue 'i ha 'api nofo'anga kau vaivai, tauhi'anga 'o e kau tisi'apiliti pe 'i ha 'api tauhi.
