Handy 5 CALD Written Resources

Here is a five-step process for putting together in your language written resources for CALD communities

1. Identify purpose and target audience of the written resource.
2. Consult with community and seek feedback
3. Develop content include professional input if required
4. Remunerate community members for their time and contributions
5. Finalize and distribute the written resource



It is important to acknowledge and value the time and contributions of community members in creating resources for CALD communities. This may involve an advocacy role to seek funding for resource creation or allocating a portion of the budget to community remuneration. By doing so, you are showing respect for the expertise and cultural knowledge of community members and creating a more equitable and inclusive process of resource creation.

Handy 5 CALD Audio Visual Resources


Here is a 5-step tool kit for putting together in your language videos to communicate key messages to CALD communities.

1. Identify purpose and target audience of the audio-visual resource and on-board professional for content input (if required)
 2. Consult with community and seek feedback
 3. Work with community members to identify language presenter of the resource
 4. Choose a relatable medium for the target audience
 5. Ensure fair remuneration for community involvement
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It is important to acknowledge and value the time and contributions of community members in creating videos for CALD communities. Ensure that community members involved in the resource are compensated fairly for their time and contributions. By doing so, you are showing respect for the expertise and cultural knowledge of community members and creating a more equitable and inclusive process of audio-visual creation.
